

# Fluffy Yeti

## What you need:

- Pair of scissors
- Glue
- Cotton wool
- Some white handicraft card
- Our template for the Yeti



## What you have to do:

1.

First, cut out all of the parts on the crafting template - except for the Yeti feet.

Take the head and fold it along the broken lines.





Next, apply glue to all of the dotted surfaces. Then, shape the head into the form of a box and use the glue to stick all the glue flaps together.



To make the ears, fold them back along the broken lines, apply glue to the dotted surfaces and attach them to the side of the head.

Now it is time to make the body: Fold the template along the broken lines too.

Here you have to apply glue to all of the dotted surfaces as well. Then, fold the body together to form a cube. This is what it looks like:





Then, glue the head to the body. Make sure the hands of the Yeti are at the sides and the stomach is at the front.

So that the feet are really stable, stick them onto a piece of white paper before you cut them out.

You'll need the glue again:  
Stick the Yeti's body to the feet.
