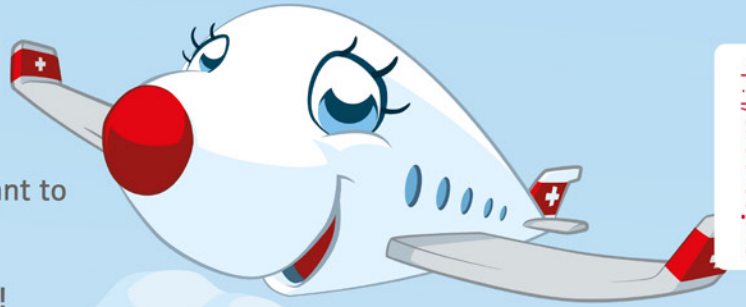


Airplane invitations

What you need:

- our template
- a pair of scissors
- coloured card
- a stick of glue
- sticky tape
- liquid glue
- a ruler
- woollen yarn
- cotton wool
- pens



What you have to do:

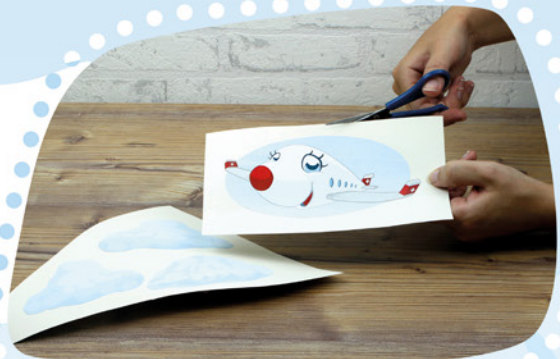
1.



Download our template and cut out Swissli and the three clouds using the scissors. You can leave a little space around the outside.

2.

Now stick Swissli and the clouds onto the coloured card using the stick of glue. Then cut them all out carefully along the lines.

Cut a piece of the woollen yarn off that is around 65 cm long.

4.

Stick the one end of the woollen yarn to the back of the airplane using the sticky tape. Pull the piece of yarn straight and stick it to the back of the clouds using another piece of sticky tape.



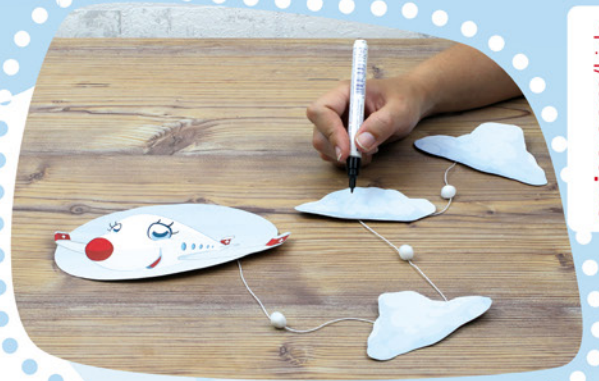

Then put a few drops of the liquid glue onto the first piece of cotton wool and stick it on top of the woollen yarn between the airplane and the first cloud. Do the same with the second and third piece of cotton wool and stick these in between the remaining clouds. Don't forget to let the glue dry properly!

All done! Your invitation card is ready. Make so many invitations that there is one for every guest you want to invite. You can write all the necessary details for the guests on the clouds, for example where and when the party is. Of course, your parents can help you.
