

Cool gift boxes

A small gift for someone you really like? If you want to wrap it up in something else rather than wrapping paper for a change, we have a great crafting idea for you: practical, small gift boxes that you can simply cut out and stick together - and voila your packaging is ready and is bound to conjure up a smile on the recipient's face!



What you need:

- our template
- a pair of scissors
- crafting cardboard or thick paper
- a glue stick
- a pen



What you have to do:



1.

Choose one of our templates. Glue the printed template with the white side onto a piece of cardboard or thick paper so that your gift box is really stable.

2.

Carefully cut it out down the solid line.



3.

Then, fold the template inwards where the dotted lines are - i.e. to the unprinted side. The printed side will be visible on the outside later.



4.

Before sticking it together, you should fill in the free field already: Write the name of the person who the gift is for. In this way, you won't get mixed up if you have made several gift boxes.

Next, assemble the box. First of all, fold the two side flaps together on the inside of the box. If you like you can dab a bit of glue on the flaps beforehand - but they do stay put without.

For the base, first of all fold the straight flap towards the middle.

Then fold the two side parts that look like an "L" also towards the middle.

Now, if you poke the long flap inwards through the free slot, the base of your box is ready.

Now place your gift for a beloved person inside the box and close the lid. To do so, fold the two straight side parts towards the middle.

Finally, fold the two halves with the motif together so that they form a heart, a Christmas tree or a cloud. Doesn't that look fantastic?
